Subject: Scholarship for internship abroad in the academic year 2015

The Faculty of Engineering aims to support and exemplify the students who achieve and maintain good academic standing in a form of a financial support. Scholarships for internship abroad are provided by the Faculty of Engineering to 3 students each in the Bilingual/English/International programs in the following fields:

- Robotic Engineering and Automation System
- Electrical Engineering
- Materials Engineering

who satisfy the following qualifications:

1. Keep an active student status whose ID no. starts with 56.
2. Must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or above from the program of study when submitting the application.
3. Must have an English test score from a standardized English testing institute, the test score must be higher than 450 for a paper-based test by TOEFL or equivalent. The Standardized English Proficiency Test by King Mongkut's University of Technology North Bangkok is also accepted with a score of 54 or above.

Note:

1. Students have to find company for internship by themselves.
2. The faculty of engineering will reimburse support a round-trip air ticket with an economy class of the lowest price in an amount not exceeding 50,000 baht per person. The students have to submit all relevant documents to the faculty of engineering before departure date as follows:

- Acceptance letter from the company
- Visa document (if any)
- Air ticket receipt

3. Students have to be responsible for all other expense such as visa, insurance, accommodation fee, etc.
4. Students have to submit an internship report to the faculty of engineering after completing the internship program.

Remarks:

- The committee's decision of each program is final.
- If there are any problems, it depends on the faculty of engineering's decision.

Please apply directly at the program of study from now to March 16th, 2016.
